Sterling Public School Instructional Model

Students will receive face-to-face instruction with no masks required.

Sterling Public Schools will not offer distance learning for the 2023-24 school year.

Sterling Public Schools will continue to work with families to meet the varying needs of students and provide the flexibility necessary to meet the needs of all our learners and their families. In some circumstances, online or blended learning modules will be offered to families and must be approved by the principal and SPS school board.

Health & Safety Protocols

The district strives to provide a healthy and safe environment for all who occupy our schools. The following guidelines are intended to provide a framework for the district's response to COVID-19.

Protect yourself and others, wash your hands often.

School staff should clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily.

Classrooms will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized nightly by custodial staff.

Classrooms, lunchroom, and hallways will have an air purifier running when school is in session.

Communication

District-level communications will be sent on an as-needed basis to inform parents of any relevant developments or changes to operations. Other communication channels, such as the

SPS website and social media accounts, will be routinely updated to reflect up-to-date information pertaining to the school.

Transportation

Buses are sanitized when needed. If needed, social distancing can be required when on the bus and each bus can have assigned seats.

Special Education

Special Education personnel will ensure that each student on an IEP will receive the services and accommodation they require and as outlined in the IEP. Should a student(s) be unable to attend school due to COVID 19 restrictions, we will come up with a plan to provide services based on their IEP.

Pandemic Measures

Operational changes could occur as a result of worsening pandemic conditions. The following levels represent different types of responses that could be implemented if deemed necessary by the Board action:

Level 1 – All Distance Learning (No Students in Schools)

Level 2 – Distance Learning with Limited Face-to-Face instruction for identified students

Level 3 – All Face-to-Face instruction for students
